The Qatar Quarries and Building Materials Company announced

that it has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Oman Holding Company to set up a new firm in Al-Minazah to manage new quarries for the extraction of Al-Jabro in Oman. The process of registering the company is expected to be completed in the coming months, and initial operation of the first quarry private company outside the State of Qatar is expected to start by the end of the year.
